We welcome Tracie Alden into the role of canteen supervisor. We look forward to working alongside her and keeping our canteen running for all students.

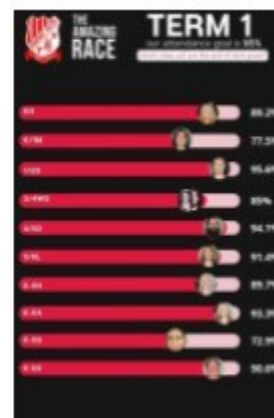
Harmony Day

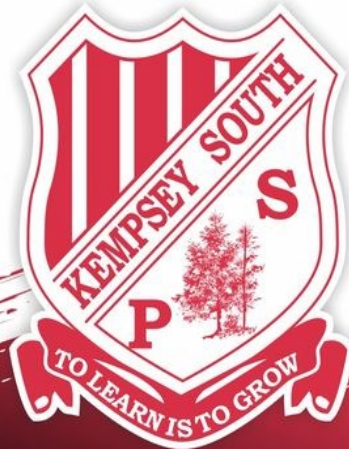

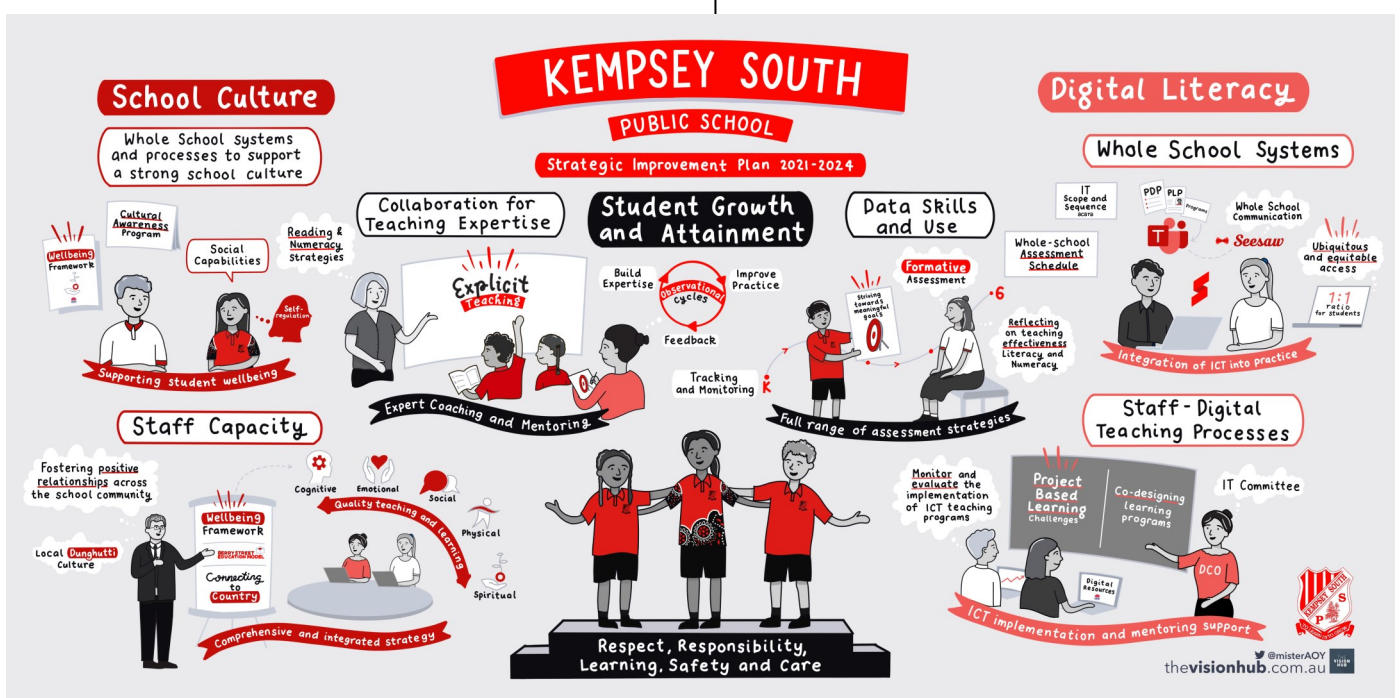
